## MISSION

The mission of the EISD School Safety and Health Advisory Council is to work collaboratively with parents, district staff and community members to provide direction, programs, and education that promote the emotional, social, and physical health of our school district families and staff, and that all work done through and by the EISD SSHAC reflects the values of the Eanes community.

## GOALS AND OBJECTIVES 2008-09

SSHAC takes its direction from the groups it serves, hence, plans for the 2008-09 school year reflect those of the EISD Superintendent, the school Principals, and District staff. From the initial meetings with these individuals, the EISD SSHAC will focus on the following areas:

- Physical Health Awareness and Education
- Social Health Awareness and Education

### **1. PHYSICAL HEALTH:**

**A. Community Programs:** Continuation of programs begun during 06-07 including flu clinics, CPR Training, AED awareness and infection prevention education.

**B. Health Curriculum:** Evaluation of the Health curriculum including content and timing for completion to meet Texas graduation requirement is underway.

**C. Fitnessgram:** SSHAC will work with EISD staff to review the processes used to pilot the Texas required physical fitness test in EISD in '08 and make recommendations for a successful implementation in spring '09.

**D. "Alive at 25":** Pilot a four-hour drivers awareness program, which is different from driver's education. *Alive at 25*, a National Law Enforcement Curriculum, is designed to teach young drivers to be aware of many of the typical driving hazards facing young motorists and has the mission of reducing automobile crashes involving young drivers and passengers.

### **2. SOCIAL HEALTH:**

#### **A. Relationship Safety**

Further investigation, assessment and recommendation of programs or curriculum that provide consistent implementation of age and audience appropriate material.

#### **B. Drug and Alcohol Prevention:**

- Provide oversight to the Eanes Underage Drinking Task Force established in 07-08

- Investigate and recommend alternative to Invest program currently used through AISD.
- Act as vehicle for information distribution to parents and the community.
- Provide synergy between Safe Homes, Eanes CARES, and SSHAC.

**C. Health Curriculums/Processes:** A committee has been established to evaluate the curriculum and processes for consistent implementation of health (including CPR), sex education and relationship education across all of our schools.
