## EANES ISD STUDENTS EXCEL ON TAKS TESTS

AUSTIN, Texas—According to preliminary results, students in the Eanes Independent School District (EISD) performed extremely well on this spring's Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) tests. In 21 of 27 categories of grade level and subject, **98 percent or more** of students met the standard, including 100 percent of students in seventh-grade Language Arts, seventh-grade Writing, eighth-grade Social Studies, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade Social Studies. At least **94 percent** of Eanes ISD students passed every test given.

Eanes ISD again had an extremely high number of students score at the Commended level, which only allows a student to miss a minimal number of answers. When looking at the 27 grade levels/subject areas, **more than half** of Eanes students scored at the Commended level on all but four tests.

The attached chart lists the percentage of EISD students who "Met the Standard" and were "Commended" in each area.

Scores previously were released for third- and fifth-grade Reading and for fifth-grade Math – subjects that students in those grades must pass in order to move to the next grade level.

Accountability ratings, which are based on TAKS results, are expected to be released in August.
