The Eanes ISD Board of Trustees unanimously approved calling an election for a \$54 million bond program, focusing on projects in the following categories: Americans with Disabilities (ADA), Curriculum and Instruction (C&I), Energy Conservation, Flooring, Painting, Plumbing, Roofing, Safety, Technology, Transportation and new construction of a facility for the Adult Transition Program (formerly the 19+ program).
