## **EANES ISD RECEIVES NATIONAL AP ACHIEVEMENT RANKING**

*District one of 388 in nation to receive recognition*

**AUSTIN, Texas** – The Eanes Independent School District is one of 388 school districts in the nation to be honored by the College Board with a place on its AP<sup>®</sup> Achievement List for opening AP classroom doors to a significantly broader pool of students, while maintaining or improving the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher.

From 2008 to 2010, Westlake High School in Eanes ISD increased the number of students participating in AP from 1,005 to 1,162, while still enabling 75 percent of AP students to earn scores of 3 or higher, the score typically needed to earn college credit. Currently, Westlake HS offers 33 AP courses, offering all but Japanese.

Eanes ISD is one of only 22 school districts in Texas to be recognized with this honor and one of just three in Central Texas (Burnett CISD and Dripping Springs ISD).

The Eanes Independent School District spans 31.2 square miles of scenic Texas Hill Country in Travis County and serves approximately 7,700 students. Schools in Eanes ISD are Westlake High School, Hill Country Middle School, West Ridge Middle School, Barton Creek Elementary, Bridge Point Elementary, Cedar Creek Elementary, Eanes Elementary, Forest Trail Elementary and Valley View Elementary.
