## **EANES ISD VOTERS PASS BOND, ELECT NEW TRUSTEES**

**AUSTIN, Texas** – Eanes ISD voters approved a \$54 million bond proposal and elected three new members to the Board of Trustees Saturday. With all precincts reporting, the bond passed with 62.91 percent for and 37.09 percent against.

The approved bond proposal focuses on projects in the following categories: Americans with Disabilities (ADA), Curriculum and Instruction (C&I), Energy Conservation, Flooring, Painting, Plumbing, Roofing, Safety, Technology, Transportation and a new facility for the Adult Transition Program (formerly the 19+ program).

“We are appreciative that Eanes ISD voters approved the bond proposal and are excited to move forward with capital improvements that will benefit our schools, students and staff,” said Dr. Nola Wellman, Superintendent of Schools. “The Board of Trustees and administration have worked for more than two years on this bond proposal so we are thankful it has passed and are ready to get to work.”

Voters also elected three new Trustees: Ronna Martin for Place 1, Rob Hargett for Place 2 and Beau Ross for Place 3. The new Trustees will be sworn in at a May 23 Special Meeting at 6:30 p.m. in the Eanes ISD Central Administration building at 601 Camp Craft Rd.

The Eanes Independent School District spans 31.2 square miles of scenic Texas Hill Country in Travis County and serves approximately 7,700 students. Schools in Eanes ISD are Westlake High School, Hill Country Middle School, West Ridge Middle School, Barton Creek Elementary, Bridge Point Elementary, Cedar Creek Elementary, Eanes Elementary, Forest Trail Elementary and Valley View Elementary. In 2010, all nine campuses and the District were named Exemplary by the Texas Education Agency for the second consecutive year.
