

“Education: Go Get It” H.B. No. 2237

Eanes Compliance Plan for H.B. 2237

The bill requires each district and charter school offering certain grade levels to designate a week of the school year as "Education: Go Get It" Week and requires each middle school, junior high school, and high school to provide students with information about higher education options available to students, standard college admission requirements, automatic college admission programs, and financial aid availability and requirements.

Designate February 15-19, 2010 as “Education: Go Get It” Week
