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## Section A - INTRODUCTION

DeskMap Systems, Inc., a consulting company based in Austin, was retained by the Eanes Independent School District (hereinafter referred to as "EISD") to produce a demographic study update. The update will provide the District with information necessary to plan for future needs. Included is an analysis of housing and residential development trends with related factors that will affect population change in the area. This information was utilized in producing enrollment projections by grade for the District.

The study report is divided into two sections:

- The **Growth Issues** section reports on the factors that will influence future enrollment growth and contains information on current and planned developments within the school district.
- The **Student Projections** section contains detailed enrollment projection tables for the school district for each grade over a five-year period. In addition to district-wide enrollment projections, enrollment projections were also produced for each campus,

## **Section B - GROWTH ISSUES**

### **FACTORS INFLUENCING FUTURE GROWTH**

#### **Birth Data**

The number of live births within a school district is sometimes used as an indicator to determine the number of Kindergarteners five years later. However, live birth data have not been a reliable indicator in many cases, especially in areas of higher migration and student transfers.

DeskMap Systems analyzed the number of live births for the ZIP Codes in Eanes ISD and determined that, although the birth data was not a strong Kindergarten indicator, the information could be used indirectly.

The total number of live births born to mothers residing within the Eanes ISD borders account for only 55% of the Kindergartens 5 years later. However, the total births show a decline in the last three years. Births increased 3.7% in these ZIP Codes from 2009 to 2010 but dropped 1.8% the next year, declined 2.9% from 2011 to 2012, and dropped another 4.5% from 2012 to 2013. Although not a strong indicator for Kindergarten enrollment, the decline in births in the region points to slow Kindergarten growth that is likely supplemented by student in-migration of pre-school children and student transfers.

## **FUTURE DEVELOPMENT**

Future residential development in the District is typically a significant factor impacting school enrollment. Knowing where the development will occur is necessary for school planning.

### **EISD RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENTS**

DeskMap Systems, Inc. identified current and planned housing developments within EISD. Where possible, the activities and plans for each major development were obtained through interviews with a representative of the project. The type of information about each project included total lots, the number of lots still available, home price information and who the target market is or the age group of most of the homebuyers. The representatives of each development were also asked what stage the development is in and an anticipated completion date.

The analysis focused on potential growth sites, those developments that may have the greatest impact on school enrollment. The findings have been factored into the enrollment projections.

A summary of the residential projects is provided in the following table. Additional information is also provided on each development at the end of this section.

## **NEW RESIDENTIAL PROJECTS**

Detailed information is provided in this section on the active residential housing developments in Eanes ISD.

### **Baldwin Tract**

The Baldwin Tract is a 48-acre tract located in far western EISD on Bee Cave Road west of the Senna Hills development. This tract was formerly part of a larger 97-acre tract owned by Eanes ISD.

There may be 140 single-family homes on the Baldwin Tract. The first homes are expected to be completed by about June 2016.

The Baldwin Tract is in the Barton Creek Elementary attendance zone in Planning Zone 1.

### **Canyons at Rob Roy**

The Canyons at Rob Roy is located on about 17 acres at 800 N. Capital of Texas Highway. Currently it is zoned to be multi-family but the developer indicated that is possible to change. There may be 225 units and construction may begin in early 2016 with an expected completion in 2018.

The Canyons at Rob Roy is in the Bridge Point Elementary attendance zone in Planning Zone 8A.

### **River Hills Tract**

The River Hills Tract is owned by EISD and is located in the far western portion of the school district. There are presently no active plans for development in the short term.

The River Hills Tract is in the Barton Creek Elementary attendance zone in Planning Zone 7.

### **Seven Oaks**

Development has been slow at Seven Oaks, a 153-lot subdivision located north of Bee Cave Road in the northwestern portion of the school district. The custom homes in Seven Oaks are priced between \$1.5 and \$3.5 million and more. As of

December 2014, there were 97 completed homes and several other homes were in various stages of construction.

The Seven Oaks subdivision has been underway for a number of years and development is likely to continue at a slower pace due to the price and size of lots and price of the homes.

This housing development is in Planning Zone 28 in the Valley View Elementary attendance zone.

### **Seven Wins**

Seven Wins is an 11-unit project located off of River Hill Road at Calle Caliche and Seven Wins Drive on a 49-acre tract. The development will be single-family homes on one to four-acre lots. Lot prices range from \$600,000 to more than \$1 million. Prices are likely to be \$2 to \$3 million or more.

As of December 2014, nine lots have been sold and two homes are now completed. Construction may begin soon on several of the sold lots.

This development project is located in Planning Zone 3 in the Barton Creek Elementary attendance zone.

### **Tarlton 360 Townhomes**

At present, the housing mix has not been finalized for the Tarlton 360 Townhomes development across from the Barton Creek Square Mall on Walsh Tarlton. There will be 46 townhomes as well as either 120 condominiums or 148 apartments. At completion, there may be 166 or 194 total housing units.

There are two sections and two developers.

The Tarlton 360 Townhomes are in the Cedar Creek Elementary attendance zone in Planning Zone 27.

### **Tipco Subdivision**

The Tipco Subdivision is a 85-acre tract near Far Gallant Drive and Scenic View Drive. There is currently one older home on this property but it has been approved for 20 additional single-family homes. Construction may begin in the first quarter of 2015. The first homes may not be completed until the 2016-17 school year.

### **Verde Heights at Lost Creek**

Verde Heights at Lost Creek is a condominium development located on Lost Creek. There will be 11 free-standing units with three stories and an elevator in each unit. Closing is expected on the first condominium in January 2015 and the first unit will be occupied in April.

Verde Heights at Lost Creek is in the Forest Heights Elementary attendance zone in Planning Zone 18.

### **Villas at Davenport**

The Villas at Davenport, previously referred to as San Clemente at Davenport, is a gated community of 32 garden home lots. The development is located in the Westlake Drive/Bunny Run area. As of December 2014, 20 homes have been sold.

This subdivision was announced in the summer of 2011 and has been slow to develop. High prices and other considerations are likely to cause the development to grow at a slower pace.

The Villas at Davenport are in the Bridge Point Elementary attendance zone in Planning Zone 9.

### **Additional Future Development**

The Balfour Tract is part of a large ranch totaling 667 acres in far western EISD. The majority of the tract is within Eanes ISD although a portion is within Lake Travis ISD. There has been no current activity on the tract in regards to development although it represents a sizable area for possible future housing construction.

## **Section C - STUDENT PROJECTIONS**

DeskMap Systems projected Eanes ISD's enrollment by grade over a 5-year period. Two scenarios were developed for the District-wide enrollment projections. Each is based upon different economic and residential growth assumptions. These scenarios are called the Conservative and Moderate Scenarios.

### **CONSERVATIVE SCENARIO**

DeskMap Systems developed projections under the Conservative Scenario based upon currently known developments and economic conditions. The Conservative projections are useful for budgeting and staff planning. District-wide projections are followed by campus projections.

### **MODERATE SCENARIO**

More robust economic conditions and greater building activity were assumed to derive enrollment projections under the Moderate Scenario. District-wide projections are followed by campus projections.

**Note: All of the enrollment projections displayed in this report are for late October of each year rather than the beginning of the school year. This is to remain consistent with the Texas Education Agency's Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) official date of late October for reporting school district enrollment data.**

**Note: Due to rounding, some totals may be slightly different from the sum of the students by grade.**
