# EANES ISD GUIDELINES

#### **TICKETS**

Our District facilities are currently operating at a 100% capacity.

All tickets will be sold online via eTix.

There will be NO tickets sold at the gate.

Ticket prices are \$5.00 adult and \$3.00 student.

Tickets will go on sale at 8:00 AM the day prior to your game.

All tickets must be purchased through the link on WestlakeNation.com.

No paper tickets. There will be no cash sales at the door.

All tickets are general admission.

All seats are on a first-come, first-served basis.

All spectators must have a ticket, or entry will not be allowed.

Once all tickets have been sold, the game will be sold out.

There will be no available tickets after a sellout.

Tickets must be downloaded in advance (screenshots to mobile devices) to be scanned at entry.

Coaches will receive 3 complimentary tickets.

Visiting Head Coaches will receive an email from Coach Blair with a link and password for their ticket allotment prior to your game.

#### LIVE-STREAMING

Westlake High School will provide a free Livestream link to all teams to watch the Varsity Home Games.

#### CONCESSIONS

Concession Stands will be fully operational this season.

### **HEALTH SCREENING REQUIREMENTS**

# EANES ISD GUIDELINES

### VISITING TEAM/PLAYER GUIDELINES

#### **ARRIVAL**

Teams may arrive up to 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to game time. Restroom Access - Teams will have access to the public restroom located behind home plate in the concession stand area.

#### **LOCKER ROOM**

No locker rooms will be available.

#### WATER

We will supply water in dugouts and injury ice. Teams need to bring their own cups and/or bottles.

#### **WARM-UP**

Please see warm-up procedures for your team's time slot to the batting cages. Practice field behind 3rd base dugout will be available at all times for teams to warm up. Westlake will not provide any equipment for Visiting Teams to use during warm-up. The practice field behind 3rd base dugout is accessible by using the gate between the visiting dugout and batting cages.

#### **TEAM SEATING**

While visiting JV teams are playing or warming up, visiting Varsity Teams may sit in the visitor bleachers if there is room. While Varsity is playing, JV teams may sit in the visiting team bleachers if there is room, or in the batting cage area adjacent to the Visiting Team dugout. The Batting Cage does have lights.

#### **FIELD RULES**

The Westlake HS Baseball Field is a turfed field. Cleats may be worn on the field. No warm-up hitting/hitting drills on the field. If pitching on the field, stay in foul territory and do not use the outfield fence as a backstop. NO GUM or sunflower seeds.

#### **GAME DAY PROCEDURES**

HOME Team will occupy the 1st base dugout.

Visiting Team will occupy the 3rd base dugout.

Cage use is only allowed during your designated time.

Do not practice batting on the field.

You may pitch in foul territory.

Do not use the outfield metal fence as a backstop.

National Anthem Procedures will be prior to the Varsity Game.
