Eanes ISD is committed to excellence in academics, extra-curriculars and co-curriculars. We prepare students for life-long success through high-quality instruction and access to a variety of opportunities and experiences.

Eanes ISD serves approximately 7,850 students at 10 schools: six elementary schools grades K-5, two middle schools grades 6-8, and one high school grades 9-12. The District also boasts an Adult Transition Services (ATS) campus for special education students who have completed state-mandated high school graduation requirements.

Meeting each student's needs is paramount in Eanes ISD. A comprehensive curriculum and a variety of enrichment opportunities are offered to Eanes ISD's students, including proudly serving as a 1:1 mobile device district since 2011.

Financially Speaking

The Eanes ISD budget is comprised of hundreds of moving parts, with 86 percent of the budget dedicated to pay salaries and benefits.

Approximately 64% of the District's tax collections - \$124 million - is sent back to the State under recapture, or the "Robin Hood" plan.

Tax rate per \$100 of assessed value: \$1.06 (\$0.94 General Fund, \$0.12 Debt Service) Avg market value of residences: \$2,143,246 Percent spent on instruction: 62% Percent spent on general admin: 4.6%

The annual financial audit resulted in an Unmodified Opinion, the cleanest audit awarded. The District was also given a perfect score with a Superior rating in the Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas (FIRST), which rates districts on the quality of financial management practices and how resources are directed towards instructional purposes.

Since 2013, Eanes ISD has refunded more than \$68 million of existing bond debt, saving \$8.5 million in interest over the life of the bonds. In that same time, more than \$15 million of principal has been retired early, saving \$10.6 million in avoided interest.
